Ordnance survey map	Is a detailed map.
Physical geography	The branch of geography that deals with natural features.
Settlement	A place where people live, which can be categorised into villages, towns and cities.
Suburb	A residential and commercial development at the edge of a city.
Country	An area of land where people live under the same government.
Town	Large group of houses, shops and factories where people live. Towns are larger than villages but smaller than cities
Urban	Relates to a town or city.
Village	Small group of houses perhaps with a few shops.


