- What are the differences between under the sea and where I live? (UW-Geography)
- What do we find at the beach? (UW- Science)
- What can we make with sand? (PD/ EAD)

Talking points at home:

- Look at sea creatures using books & pictures - what would it feel like to be one of these creatures?
- Talk about experiences when you may have visited the seaside/ been in the sea.
